




## 4.3.1 Access to Educational Resources



The University of the Visayas (UV), through its Academic Resource Center (ARC), has broadened access to knowledge resources by formalizing open-access protocols for alumni, the general public, and external researchers. This initiative reflects UV's commitment to ensuring that learning opportunities extend beyond enrolled students and reach the wider community.

Under the ARC's guidelines, alumni may use the center's resources by presenting their alumni ID, while external researchers are admitted through referrals from their home institutions. All users are expected to observe ethical standards in their work, with access aligned to UV's "FREEducation" Program, which promotes inclusive and equitable learning.

UV's admissions and outreach policies also mandate compliance with Department of Education (DepEd) standards. In 2024, UV received formal communication from DepEd authorizing and endorsing the extension of its academic resources and facilities to learners from public schools and partner institutions. This communication validates UV's policy of inclusivity and non-discrimination, guaranteeing that access is open regardless of ethnicity, religion, economic status, disability, immigration status, or gender.

The ARC serves as a dynamic knowledge hub, equipped with modern facilities, digital databases, and research services. It has welcomed visiting researchers from partner universities and public institutions, offering access to books, journals, and online platforms. The center is open daily from 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., underscoring UV's dedication to inclusivity, partnerships and lifelong learning.

Through DepEd's endorsement, UV formalized partnerships with local schools such as Mabolo National High School, enabling learners to access its facilities through Work Immersion programs. A total of 16 Grade 12 learners from the Academic/Humanities & Social Sciences and STEM strands were formally endorsed for immersion activities, gaining exposure to higher education environments and academic support.

Referrals from Bohol Island State University and the University of Eastern Philippines enabled at least eight graduate students to complete dissertations and theses using UV's resources. DepEd-endorsed Work Immersion brought 16 Grade 12 learners into UV's facilities, representing diverse socio-economic and cultural backgrounds.

By opening its doors more widely, UV strengthened academic collaboration across Regions VII and VIII, contributing to measurable gains in research productivity, professional development, and preparedness for higher education.

## 1.0 Objectives

To provide the Alumna/Alumni, the public and other researchers a clear guidelines on the process of using and accessing any resources in the Academic Resource Center of the University of the Visayas.

## 2.0 Scope

This is applicable to all Alumna/Alumni, the public and other researchers of the University of the Visayas and other Researchers outside of the University.

## 3.0 Guidelines

- 3.1 Alumna/Alumni should present her/his Alumni ID, while other researchers should present their Referral Letter from the head of their respective institution at the Circulation Counter.
- 3.2 Any Alumna/Alumna will not be allowed to use the ARC resources without the Alumni ID, while other researchers will not be allowed to use the same without the required Referral Letter.
- 3.3 The public is encouraged to visit the Academic Resource Center to access academic resources.
- 3.4 Researchers can do research between 8am to 5pm only.
- 3.5 Researchers can use any ARC resources inside the ARC only.
- 3.6 Researchers are not allowed to loan-out books from the ARC.
- 3.7 Researchers should follow the guidelines while inside the ARC premises.

Gathered data will be retained for three (3) years, after which it will be permanently deleted from the database.




The Senior High School students of Mabolo National High School will undergo Work Immersion in the different industries with the aim of providing learners opportunities:
